

रामाय रामभद्राय रामचन्द्राय वेधसे ।

रघुनाथाय नाथाय सीतायाः पतये नमः ॥

*rāmāya rāmabhadrāya rāmacandrāya vedhase  
raghunāthāya nāthāya sītāyāḥ pataye namaḥ*

Salutations to Lord Rāma, the wise, who shines and pleases like the Moon (therefore known as Rāmacandra) who is of the nature of auspiciousness (hence known as Rāmabhadra), exalted among the kings of the Ragu clan and husband of Sītā.

*rāmāya* – to Rāma

*rāmabhadrāya* – that Rāma who is of the nature of auspiciousness

*rāmacandrāya* – that Rāma who shines and pleases like the Moon

*vedhase* – pious, virtuous, wise (*vedhas*)

*ragunāthāya* – lord or king (*nāthāya*) of the Ragu clan

*nāthāya* – to the Lord

*sītāyāḥ* – of Sītā

*pataye* – to the husband

*namaḥ* – salutations
